WHAT IS MAINE CHILDREN'S SCHOLARSHIP FUND?

The Maine Children's **Scholarship Fund** (MCSF) provides scholarships to Maine children in grades K-12 to help pay for part of public, private or homeschool expenses. MCSF provides 75 percent of tuition per child up to \$1,700 and the families contribute at least 25 percent. MCSF reimburses home schooling cost up to \$500 per child. Scholarships are awarded to all school aged children in a family. To qualify, family income must be at or below the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program.
